Medium straw hue. Well focused aromas of fig, ripe apple, orange, apricot, and butterscotch in this youthful Chardonnay. These characters continue their abundance on the palate while being balanced by a light dose of oak and some richness from lees contact. This wine is very open and accessible to immediate enjoyment. Drink now through 2016.

APPELLATION

For Testarossa's Cuvée Los Gatos releases, Rob and Diana Jensen and Director of Winemaking Bill Brosseau select and combine vineyard lots from highly regarded growing districts. For this bottling, the grapes were sourced from Monterey County. In particular, a majority of the fruit came from vineyards in the northern end of the Santa Lucia Highlands appellation - one of the state's best known regions for world-class Chardonnay. The Highlands close proximity to Monterey Bay makes for a very cool climate, with one of California's longest growing seasons. The resulting slow, gentle ripening allows for full flavor development on the vine.
